Appellation: A.O.C Haut-Médoc
Location: Macau
Property Purchase: 1982
1st Vintage: 1999
Surface: 1,5 ha
Vineyard's average age: 25 years old
Density of plantation: 6 600 plants/ha
Yield: 45 hl/ha
Grape Varieties: 30% Merlot, 70% Cabernet Sauvignon
Soil: Gravely soil dating from the tertiary period
Annual production: 4 300 to 7 000 bottles depending on vintages.

VINIFICATION

Harvest by plots of vineyard.
Sorting by hand.
Cold macerations pre fermenting..
Alcoholic fermentations in stainless steel thermo regulated vats followed by micro-oxygenation.
Malolactic fermentations in vats.

MATURING

Blending before ageing in barrels.
100% French oak barrels, medium roast, fine grain.
10 different coopers
100% new oak
24 months maturing depending on vintages
The wine is fined and filtered

KEEPING TIME

Will reach maturity in 6 to 8 years
Château Braude Fellonneau can be laid down for 15 years.
